



KU Scholarship 2019 for International Students

In 2019, the KU offers academically qualified international students¹ in need a scholarship in order to promote internationalisation at our university. This scholarship is funded by the Bavarian Ministry of Education and Culture, Science, and Art.

Funding term for summer: 1 April 2019 – 31 August 2019

Funding term for winter: 1 October 2019 – 29 February 2020

This scholarship includes 336,00 € per month.

Prerequisites:

- Academic qualification
- Personal qualification
- You have not yet exceeded the maximum funding period (36 months) for this scholarship.
- You are enrolled as a student at the KU (campus Eichstätt or campus Ingolstadt) during the funding period.
- Advanced studies with good study performance (from 3rd semester onwards)
- Financial need.

Selection criteria and prerequisites / necessary documents:

- Signed application form
- Certificate of enrollment of the KU (international degree-seeking students) or Letter of Admission of the KU (incoming exchange students)
- proof of academic achievement or transcript of records
- at least one letter of recommendation from a KU professor (degree-seeking students) or a professor from your home university (exchange students)
- CV in tabular form in English
- letter of motivation (one page)
- proof of nationality

Application deadline:

- 1 March 2019 for the funding term summer (1 April 2019 – 31 August 2019)
- 1 September 2019 for the funding term winter (1 October 2019 – 29 February 2020)

¹ International students are international students who wish to complete their studies at KU (degree-seeking students) or international students who wish to come for one semester within one of our programs at KU (exchange students).
